## PHONY SERVICE DOG SCAM

Businesses in the Lower Mainland BC are cautioned to be on the lookout for **JESSICA SERENITY SIMPSON, aka JESSICA YANIV**. Simpson is accused of defrauding and extorting area businesses for personal profit by misrepresenting themselves and misleading people. Simpson's most recent fraudulent behaviour is to entrap businesses by bringing in a puppy that she identifies as a service dog. The dog has a vest that identifies it as a service dog and Simpson may have an ID card that appears genuine but is not.

In 2016, the B.C. government passed a law that required dogs to pass a test before they could identify themselves as service dogs or guide dogs and be treated as such. The dogs are given a card that looks like a B.C. drivers licence that they can present if questioned. **Simpson's dog is not trained nor certified as a service dog. Fake service dogs should not be granted the same benefits as actual service dogs.**

### Fake Service Dog Warning Signs

tugging on the leash or needing frequent correction	barking, whining, or sniffing around
indoor "accidents"	needs special equipment (i.e., shock or prong collar)
unable to display any specialized skills	the dog's name is displayed or announced
aggressive behaviour (showing teeth, ears back, growls)	attention seeking behaviour
stealing food	general unfocused behaviour or nervousness

Simpson is described as Caucasian, 5'11 - 6'0" tall, 350 lbs, shoulder length hair, often wears wigs with longer hair and may carry a cane, use braces, or appear disabled. Simpson is facing two upcoming criminal trials for violent offenses. Simpson is extremely litigious and weaponizes the court system for personal gain.

Other allegations against Simpson include the filing of racist and profit-fueled complaints against businesses (alleging discrimination), as well as illegal and illicit online grooming behaviour with underage girls, potentially compounded by the puppy situation.
